History of Sage-ing® International

Sage-ing® International (SI) has grown from a seed planted by Rabbi Zalman Schachter-Shalomi at a gathering of nearly 100 Sage-ing Leaders (persons trained to teach the philosophy of sage-ing) in the Fall of 2004. There, Rabbi Schachter-Shalomi, or Reb Zalman as he was known by many, relayed his vision of a professional association that would facilitate cooperation and exchange of ideas between current Sage-ing Leaders as well as provide a structure for the training of future Sage-ing Leaders.

Sage-ing® International, which was known from 2004 until 2012 as the Sage-ing Guild, was preceded organizationally by the Spiritual Eldering Institute (SEI), which served as the public face of sage-ing work for over a decade. Following the 2005 closing of SEI, and with the support of Reb Zalman, SI picked up where SEI left off, assuming the role of training and certifying new Sage-ing Leaders and serving as a networking and support group for approximately 200 Certified Sage-ing Leaders and Sage-ing Circle Facilitators in North America, Canada and Australia. Today, SI also serves a membership of more than 3300 who are not Sage-ing Leaders, but have an interest in sage-ing philosophy.

Sage-ing Leader Certification Program

The Sage-ing Leader Certification Program is structured to provide content and experience relevant to leading adult groups in personal and spiritual development workshops. Interns attend a beginning and final weekend of training, complete 15 hours leading community workshops or programs while working with a Certified Sage-ing Leader (CSL) mentor, and participate in a Wisdom Circle monthly via conference call.

As in the training of all healing practitioners, we must first apply "the practical work of translating theory into practice in the laboratory of our own life." Sage-ing International faculty have concluded that the introspective inner work and the presentation skills required in the training program take about a year from the initial training weekend to complete.
